
## JOSEPH IS SOLD BY HIS BROTHERS

1	DOWN	"Now Israel loved Joseph more than all his children, because he was the son of his old age. Also he made him a tunic of many" <b>GENESIS 37:3</b>
3	ACROSS	"But when his saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers, they hated him and could not speak peaceably to him." <b>GENESIS 37:4</b>
9	ACROSS	"Now Joseph a dream, and he told it to his brothers; and they hated him even more." <b>GENESIS 37:5</b>
7	ACROSS	"Then his brothers went to feed their father's flock in Shechem. And Israel said to Joseph, 'Are not your brothers the flock in Shechem? Come, I will send you to them.' So he said to him, 'Here I am.' " GENESIS 37:12-13
6	DOWN	"Now when they saw him afar off, even before he came near them, they conspired against him to kill him. Then they said to one another, 'Look, this dreamer is coming! Come therefore, let us now kill him and cast him into some; and we shall say, "Some wild beast has devoured him." We shall see what will become of his dreams!' " <b>GENESIS 37:18-20</b>
5	DOWN	"And Reuben said to them, 'Shed no blood, but cast him into this pit which is in the wilderness, and do not lay a hand on him' - that he might him out of their hands, and bring him back to his father."  GENESIS 37:22
2	ACROSS	"Then Midianite traders passed by; so the brothers pulled Joseph up and lifted him out of the pit, and him to the Ishmaelites for twenty shekels of silver. And they took Joseph to Egypt."  GENESIS 37:28
8	ACROSS	"Then they sent the tunic of many colors, and they brought it to their father and said, 'We have found this. Do you know whether it is your son's tunic or not? And he recognized it and said, 'It is my son's tunic. A wild beast has devoured him. Without doubt is torn to pieces.' " <b>GENESIS 37:32-33</b>
4	DOWN	"And all his sons and all his daughters arose to comfort him; but he to be comforted, and he said, 'For I shall go down into the grave to my son in mourning.' Thus his father wept for him." <b>GENESIS 37:35</b>
