
WANDERING IN THE WILDERNESS

4	ACROSS	"The LORD said to Moses: 'How long will these people Me? And how long will they not believe Me, with all the signs which I have performed among them?' " NUMBERS 14:11
8	ACROSS	The LORD said, "The carcasses of you who have murmured against Me shall fall in this, all of you who were numbered, according to your entire number, from twenty years old and above." NUMBERS 14:29
5	DOWN	The LORD also said, "Except for Caleb the son of Jephunneh and Joshua the son of Nun, you shall by no meansthe land which I swore I would make you dwell in." NUMBERS 14:30
6	ACROSS	"Then He said, "But your little ones, whom you said would be victims, I will bring in, and they shall know the land which you have" NUMBERS 14:31
2	ACROSS	"According to the number of days in which you spied out the land, forty days, for each day you shall bear your guilt one year, namely years, and you shall know My rejection." NUMBERS 14:34
7	DOWN	"I the LORD have spoken this; I will surely do so to all this evil congregation who are gathered together against Me. In this wilderness they shall be consumed, and there they shall" NUMBERS 14:35
3	DOWN	"Those very men who brought the evil about the land, died by the plague before the LORD. But Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb the son of Jephunneh remained alive, of the men who went to spy out the land." NUMBERS 14:37-38
